<u>THE SHEPHERD'S VOICE</u>

Dear Parishioners,

Jesus taught the people of the Holy Land about spiritual realities by comparing them to processes familiar to them in nature, in farming, in fishing, etc. For me that works; I can understand today's parable from watching the care my grandmother used to take with her rose bushes.

Three points are developed in this parable. First of all, Jesus is describing a life <u>in him</u> ("in Christ", as St. Paul always says), a very intimate relationship. Without the flow of this life in Christ, without the grace of God inside us, there is no life; we just wither and fade away.

The Christ-life needs to receive careful attention in order for it to grow as we ourselves are growing. And so we will find ourselves making sacrifices and enduring hardships, being "pruned" like a vine, in order to strengthen God's life within us.

And finally, through our efforts and the grace of God we hope to offer the Lord, who gave us our life and so much more, "much fruit" that will bring him glory and earn us eternal life with God.


