

THE SHEPHERD'S VOICE

Dear Parishioners,

Although we do not often consider it, the Transfiguration is a very important feast. It was a revelation of **Jesus**' true nature; for a moment the glory that he had laid aside in the Incarnation shone forth from within him and showed him to be God the Father's "beloved Son" with whom he was well pleased.

Peter, James, and John were given a glimpse of his glory so that in the difficult days ahead, recalling this manifestation of the Lord's divinity, they might remain faithful through the coming trials and strengthen the other **disciples**.

For **us**, celebrating this mystical experience so many years later, our Master's Transfiguration is one more proof of his status as God, testified to by God himself. It is also a great source of hope, as we realize that the glory he radiated on Mount Tabor is the glory that all the faithful are promised to share in heaven. Recall the first words of the funeral liturgy: "In the waters of baptism N. died with Christ and rose with him to new life. May he now share with him eternal glory."

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL FOOD PANTRY


Please continue to help us stock the shelves of our Food Pantry by bringing to the Rectory Office "non-expired" cans and boxes of food items. Monetary con-


