THE SHEPHERD'S VOICE

Dear Parishioners.

The more familiar you become with the gospels, the more obvious it is that Jesus is telling his disciples to act toward others the way they have experienced God has been treating them. By listening to Jesus and by watching how he acts we can clearly see how God relates to sinners: he seeks them out and extends limitless mercy, forgiveness.

Most of us operate like baseball umpires: three strikes and you're out. Peter thought he was being very generous in volunteering seven acts of forgiveness to one individual. Jesus, however, requires (according to which translation you read) 7 x 7 (49) times or 70 x 7 (490) times. He doesn't expect us to count; the huge number means we should never refuse forgiveness.

The parable makes his reason clear: the servant owed his master 150,000 years of wages, about \$2 or \$3 billion in today's money! His fellow servant owed him just 100 days' wages or about \$5,000. When the Master, God, can cancel such an enormous debt, who are we to deny others, when they make the same appeal that we have made to the Lord? Something to seriously consider. It is high time to let go of our petty grudges and resentments, so that we can pray, "Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us."


