

THE SHEPHERD'S VOICE

Dear Parishioners.

Jesus was being questioned by the religious leaders as to what authority he had to teach; they were often resistant to his efforts. When he spoke to the crowds, however, he found many people, including the tax collectors and prostitutes, who were considered "lost souls" because they were making money by collaborating with the Romans, showed that they were actually ready to make changes in their lives.


To wake those leaders up he told them that tax collectors and prostitutes would find their way to heaven before them. You can guess how angry those words made them. But the entrance to the kingdom of heaven is never closed; it is never too late to change for the good. Each individual – not his parents or his ancestors – is responsible for his own life, his own actions, as Ezechiel explained. A stance of humility, a willingness to listen and learn, a change of heart, and they too can be saved.

Paul urged the Philippians to put on the mind and heart of Jesus Christ, an attitude not of pride, but of humility and service, a focus on others before oneself, a way that creates unity. That would be the kingdom of God realized!


