

#### THE SHEPHERD'S VOICE

Dear Parishioners,

At a difficult time in the history of his people, Isaiah, speaking for God, promised them a lush banquet, with rich meats and fine wines, to be set on a mountain top (Zion). He also prophesied the end to death and mourning. This became a symbol for the blessings of the messianic era. In today's gospel Jesus pictures the marriage feast of the great king's son (himself) as an image of the "kingdom of heaven".

All is ready and the king invites his people (the chief priests and elders) to this remarkable celebration, but they do not even respond. The king then reaches out beyond the list of those invited to anyone who can be found (gentiles) in an effort to fill the hall and share his generous gifts. Even then one is found to be unworthy, not wearing a wedding garment (a clean baptismal robe).

In this story Jesus was repeating a theme he voiced over and over again in his final days: you (the children of Israel) were privileged to have been chosen by God for great blessings, but you have not responded and so God will turn to others (the gentiles). "The first will be last"; "tax collectors and prostitutes" may well "enter the kingdom before us".

Will you be among the few who are chosen for the banquet of the Lamb?
