#### THE SHEPHERD'S VOICE

Dear Parishioners.

Today begins a special time in the Catholic Church, "National Vocation Awareness Week" (November 5-11). Is it possible that God is calling you to serve his people in the priesthood, diaconate, religious life, or lay ministry in the Church?

Before you quickly answer "No!" I would ask you to sit with these questions. Do you provide enough quiet time in your life to listen for what God might be saying to you? If so, what do you hear? Do you feel dissatisfied with the direction your life has taken? Then in what direction do you want to move? Do you see work that needs to be done for and with God's people? Who is going to do that today and in years tocome? Do you think it might be you?

The readings of today's Mass are very strong. In Malachi's time God expressed disappointment in his priests, and called them to keep faith with God and his people. Could you do that? St. Paul remembers how gentle and affectionate he was with those to whom he brought the word of God, how he labored night and day and shared his very self with them. Could you be that open, devout, and dedicated? St. Matthew warns us not to seek titles like teacher, father, or master, but to have the humility to serve always. Could you be so focused on the Lord that you could direct everyone away from you to Christ himself?

If you find yourself answering "Yes" to the above questions, you may very well have a "call", a "vocation" to serve God in the Church.

#### STOCK THE FOOD PANTRY SHELVES




Our **SUNDAY LITURGY OF THANKSGIVING** will take place on **November 12**<sup>th</sup> at the 10:00 am Mass.




