Dear Parishioners,


The parable of the ten bridesmaids is one where people often get lost in minor details (why didn't the five wise maids share their oil; why couldn't the five foolish maids go into the banquet without oil?) and miss the forest for the trees. Scripture scholars tell us that Jesus had <u>one</u> main point in all of his parables. What is that here?

His point seems very clear: "Stay awake" is his message; "Be prepared" at all times. All ten of the bridesmaids fell asleep because of the long wait late at night. Five of them had prepared all they might need for the bridegroom's arrival, and those five went in to the wedding banquet, a frequent image of heaven. For the others the door was shut, the opportunity of a lifetime lost.

How, then, do we prepare? Focus; look at how you spend your time, and make sure that you are putting the Lord first and that you are finding opportunities to serve others, to assist them in their needs. Stay alert; be wise, be prudent. And remember what the foolish virgins learned: no one else can do this work for you.
