I found 21 photos of natural disasters and accidents, 8 connected with war, 7 of shootings, and 6 of protests.


Anyone who reads newspapers or news magazines or watches the news on television could guess that would be true; death and disaster and scandal are the very meat of the news. Rarely do we hear about the good fortune or good deeds of people.

We tend to get reflective as we approach the end of one year and the beginning of another. A new year offers us hope for better times and we plan to be better people. Might I suggest that we examine our past year's experiences for things that went well for us, for moments when we felt God had blessed us in some way? It is healthy and healing to appreciate what is good in our lives.

During Advent Isaiah gave us signs of the Messiah's presence and activity among his people: "good news" preached to the poor, healings – sight to the blind, freedom – release from captivity, jubilee – a year of God's favor. Do you think we might see such signs in 2024? Could this be a year of favor from the Lord?
