

THE SHEPHERD'S VOICE

Dear Parishioners,

Job's words weigh heavily on us today with his sense that man's life is a "drudgery", with months of misery and nights that drag on, and with his certainty that he will not see happiness again. We can be patient with him, knowing the incredible reversal of fortune that he faced.

But we have in the gospel quite a different model in a man who works hard and wants to come back and work hard again the next day, and the next. Jesus leaves the synagogue, where he confronted and expelled a demon, only to be led to Peter's house, where his mother-in-law lay sick. He restores her to good health and spends the rest of his day attending to the sick and possessed of Bethsaida, to the point that the whole town seems to be at the door.

Tired? Certainly, but he rises early in order to withdraw and pray to God his Father. That is his secret; in prayer Jesus recognizes his purpose and finds the energy he needs to continue to embody the compassion of God in village after village.

Do we call on that source of energy and insight at the start of each day's work, or do we dread another dreary day?

LENTEN REGULATIONS REMINDER

ABSTINENCE: All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age are required to abstain totally from meat on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent.


FASTING: All the faithful between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive, are bound to fast on Ash

Wednesday and Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may also be taken on two other occasions during the day.
