# THE SHEPHERD'S VOICE

Dear Parishioners,

We have gone from Jesus in the desert and the community of the saved in an ark on the flood waters to the top of a mountain and three apostles' vision of the glory of God shining through Jesus. Why does the Church present the Transfiguration to us every Lent?

It is a revelation of who Jesus truly is: the completion of the Law and of all the prophets (Moses and Elijah) and the beloved Son of God. The voice identifies him and the very glory of God shines through him.

Love and relationship will eventually require us to sacrifice for the good of the loved one. Abraham is willing to sacrifice his only son, Isaac, to show his love for God; God does sacrifice his only Son for love of us. Lent is a long haul and we may very well find ourselves tiring with regard to our prayer, fasting, and charity. This vision of Jesus' glory, and our promised glory in heaven, is meant to encourage us on that long, upward climb to holiness.

The key words of this gospel were spoken by God to the three apostles: "Listen to him." They are very similar to Mary's advice to the waiters at the wedding in Cana: "Do whatever he tells you." This is the whole point of our Lenten observances, to clear away space and time for us to hear the voice of the Lord, and to fine tune our readiness to go wherever he leads us, to do whatever he asks.
