

### THE SHEPHERD'S VOICE

Dear Parishioners,

John places the cleansing of the temple in the beginning of Jesus' ministry. In doing so he tells us quite a bit about Jesus. One of the scriptural expectations for the Messiah was that he would purify the worship of God in the temple. The reason for his display of anger – a righteous anger – was that all of the exchanging of money and purchasing animals for the sacrifices was disruptive of real worship of his Father. Worship is neither business nor an act of barter; it is the offering of oneself, of one's heart. It was his zeal for God that fueled such a decisive action.

His words that seemed to threaten destruction to the temple (and it was razed in 70 AD by the Roman occupying forces) were misunderstood by the onlookers. Even the disciples, according to John, only understood him after the resurrection. The temple Jesus referred to was his body; as God and man he would replace the temple in Jerusalem as the new meeting place of God and man. He would be the priest who offers true worship to God in the Spirit.

It is that pure worship that we offer to our God daily in the Eucharist.




