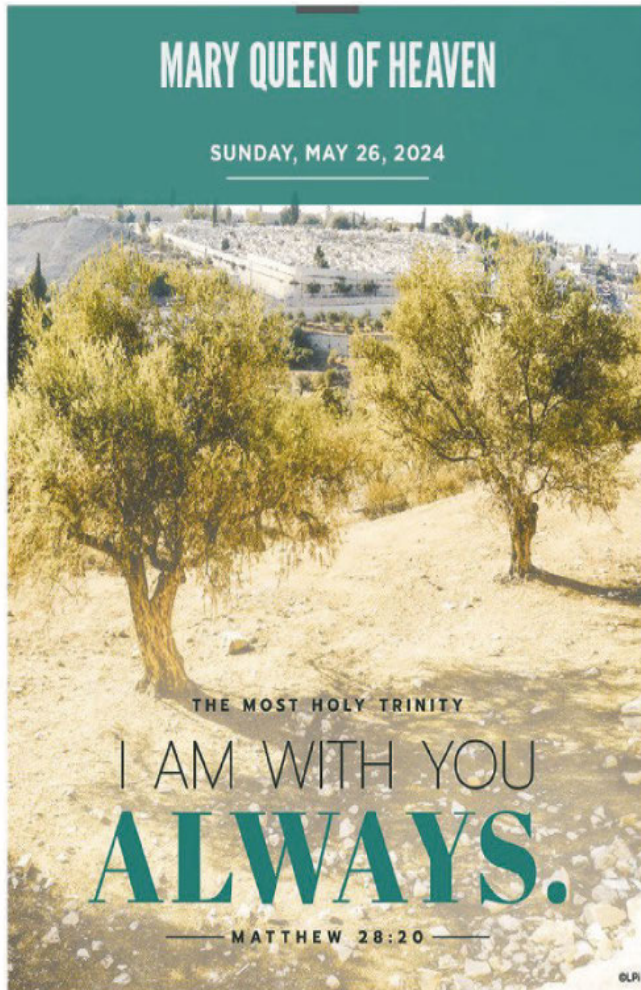

safely into your kingdom of justice and peace.

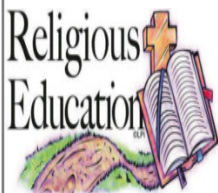
