#### THE SHEPHERD'S VOICE

Dear Parishioners.

The Word of God, Hebrews tells us, is sharp and penetrating, it cuts a person to the core of his being. That is certainly true of what the rich man heard from Jesus in today's gospel (Mark 10).

He came and knelt before Jesus with a sense that he had done quite a good job with his life, having been so faithful in keeping the commandments. But there was something "more" that the Master wanted from him. He offered him an invitation to intimacy with him in discipleship, "Go, sell what you have, and give to the poor and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me." But the young man went away saddened, for he wanted to keep his treasure now.

I often wonder whether the man reconsidered his decision, whether he might have realized that Jesus had offered him the "one thing necessary" in this life. There wasn't much time left to change his mind; Jesus had almost reached Jerusalem and thus the end of his ministry.

What about you? As the Lord looks at **you** with love and asks you to let go of other things to trust him and go with him, how do you respond?




