Stewardship Thought

“The stone which the builders rejected has become the cornerstone.”

1 PETER 2:7

Every person has been given gifts from the Holy Spirit. These are called “charisms” and they are used to build God’s kingdom of earth. While many people are able to recognize their natural talents and abilities, they may be unsure of their charisms. If you know someone who is struggling for a direction in life, give them a little encouragement. Help them discern their charisms and how God is calling them to use them. Remember - no gift is too small or insignificant in God’s salvation plan.

IT IS NOT RIGHT FOR US TO NEGLECT THE WORD OF GOD

Many of older generations will note that in their younger years there was an active discouragement on the part of Church leaders regarding the faithful reading the Bible. In some cases, it was likely true and in others more of a misperception but either way there was a legitimate concern. Could people not schooled in the Bible really understand what it is saying without falling into error? There have been countless heresies and splits in the Christian Church due heavily to misinterpretations of the Bible. Even racism and opposition to interracial marriages have been very incorrectly made a Biblical precept by the most extreme readers of the Bible. It is why members of the KKK would lynch people on Saturday night and sing the Lord's praises on Sunday morning. It was a complete and horrid distortion of Sacred Scripture. Thousands of Christian denominations have also sprung up based on one particular person's self-regarding interpretation of the Bible. There is a simple fact that we need to know. The Bible as we know it, was put together in the late 4th century (particularly the Council of Rome in 382 AD) by the Pope and Bishops of the Roman Catholic Church after decades of study and deliberations as to which books go back to the Apostolic period and could be confirmed to have been written by the various authors or their communities. It makes eminent sense that the Church that gave us the Bible – preceded by the oral tradition – would also be its guarantor of correct interpretation. Otherwise, we have what we have today, thousands of denominations slanted towards the interpretation of a particular pastor. All this said and written, we must not “neglect the Word of God,” or as the Acts of the Apostles tells us it is simply “not right” to neglect God's word. God's Word is not a history book whose presentations are of an ancient period. Rather, God's word is a “two-edged sword” that cuts to the very depths of our souls not with a cut of pain but with a cut of conviction that is meant to make of us new creations in Christ made in the image and likeness of God. They are words of life and peace which reveal God to us definitively in Christ opening up for us the pathway to heaven. As St. Jerome wrote, “ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ.” It makes perfect sense. Sacred Scripture shows us who Jesus is. If we neglect Sacred Scripture then we cannot know Jesus; or else we manufacture a Jesus or God of our own imagination or liking. There is no excuse for any of us not to delve into the Word of God. Countless Catholic websites exist that offer Bible studies. Bible studies have been offered at both Mary Queen of Heaven and St. Bernard of Clairvaux Churches. Fr. Tom Leach continues these courses every Fall and Spring. We do not have to be scholars to become part of a Bible study. We do need though to have a desire to know Jesus more intimately and in a more complete way just as we need to spend time with another person we want to get to know better. I have suggested it in the past and I do so once again: Lectio Divina. The late Pope Benedict XVI said during his pontificate that if every Catholic practiced Lectio Divina (sacred reading), that alone would reform the Church. Lectio Divina helps us meditate and contemplate the Word of God and what it is saying to us in our own personal walk in faith. It is God speaking to us heart to heart. It is as easy as googling “lectio divina,” to find the many sites that show how to pray the Word of God and not just hear it. I encourage everyone to spend at least ten minutes every morning with the Word of God and allow that Word to speak to you throughout the day. It will make a difference as we keep in mind that it truly is not right for us to neglect the Word of God for to do so is to neglect God Himself.

Once that happens there will be celebrations at both MQH and SBC to recognize our union as one parish family.

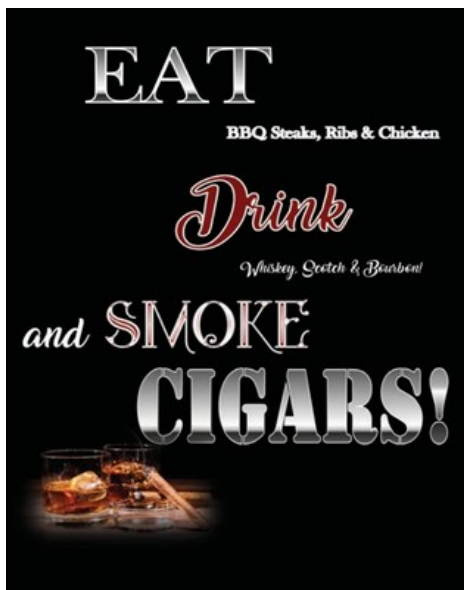

LIVING ROSARY

On Wednesday, May 13, the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima, a celebration of the Living Rosary will be held at Mary Queen of Heaven Church. I have offered the prayer of this Rosary at other parishes where I have served and I believe the parishioners of MQH would

find this a peaceful and prayerful time with our Lord and our Lady. The Living Rosary is a candlelight rosary where participants ring the church with candles (batter operated for safety), blue for the Hail Marys, white for the Our Fathers, and red for the Glory Be. At the end of the service the church is ringed with a lighted rosary prayed and held by those participating. We will need 53 parishioners for the Hail Mary, 6 for Our Father, and 5 for the Glory Be. I will be approaching the various ministries at MQH to invite them to take a decade. Individuals who would like to participate are encouraged to do so. Others can pray from the pews if they are not comfortable with public speaking. The Living Rosary will begin at 8:00 pm so that it can be reasonably dark. At the Conclusion we will have fellowship with refreshments outdoors, behind the church, weather permitting. A sign-up sheet will be available, or you may call the MQH Rectory Office to indicate your interest in participating. On the night of the Living Rosary, I will assign participants their prayer.
