Stewardship Thought

“The seed sown among thorns is the one who hears the word but then the cares of the world and the lure of riches choke the word and it bears no fruit.”

- MATTHEW 13:22

Gratitude and generosity are virtues that we should strive to do on a daily basis. Every decision we make either takes us one step closer to God or one step further away. What we receive at Mass every Sunday should be shared with others all the other days of the week as we

HEARING BUT NOT LISTENING

Many a parent has complained about “talking to the wall” when they talk to their children. The children certainly hear their parent’s voice but they choose to not listen very attentively to the words, usually so that they do not have to do whatever it is the parent is asking; or at the very least wanting to finish what they are doing without interruption. This can go on in any relationship. At times we can simply choose to be deaf, or what is sometimes called “selective hearing.” Unfortunately, for more than a few Christians, the same attitude pervades our hearing of God’s Word. We know there is a Bible; we know that Jesus and the Apostles taught many things; we have heard enough of the teachings to be able to recite them. Yet they do not always penetrate how we live. We have heard but have we listened? The Word of God, as the Letter to the Hebrews tells us, “Cuts like a two-edged sword...it exposes our innermost thoughts and desires.” No one likes being cut and those whose “innermost thoughts and desires” are something not to be proud of, make it understandable why many would choose to be deaf, to hear but not to listen, for the Word of God convicts us. This conviction is truly a two-edged sword. On one edge is the awareness that some of our attitudes, beliefs, actions, choices, lifestyles are in fact at odds with God’s will and our own dignity and destiny. The other edge is the invitation to conversion and a new life. However, to get to that place of the freedom of the sons and daughters of God does demand a cost from us, just as our Lord had to go through Good Friday to get to Easter Sunday. Examining our consciences in the light of God’s Word can be a Calvary that forces us to face those parts of our lives where darkness may have dulled our consciences, attitudes that may have poisoned our Christian character, choices that may have demeaned ourselves and others. For those seeking the Lord with a sincere heart this willingness to not only hear but listen to the Word of God will in fact require much. It cannot be done without a lived faith and a determination to become all that God intends us to be. It also cannot be done unless we have a keen awareness of our destiny, which is eternal glory for the faithful. As we hear this Sunday in the Gospel from St. Matthew this problem of hearing but not listening is an age-old one. The seed, which is the Word of God, falls on those whose faith is deep and on those whose faith is mediocre, those who have lost faith through a caving in to the temptations around them, and to those whose faith was shallow and on those who were not interested much in God to begin with. Yet the first reading from the Prophet Isaiah tells us that the Word of God will “not return” to God “void.” It will accomplish its purpose. Here is the important caveat. It accomplishes its work for those who receive it in its fullness. It makes the faithful person more “fertile and fruitful” for God always responds with His grace those who are seeking Him with their whole heart. These people become more fertile so that the Word of God can penetrate their lives evermore deeply. As this happens, they bring forth even greater fruits of faith, hope, charity, and justice. They live in the light of God’s truth alone. These Christians become the light of the world and the salt of the earth.

The readings this Sunday invite us and challenge us to once again examine our own lives and to ask ourselves without self-justification, whether we are just hearing, or more importantly, listening to God’s Word.

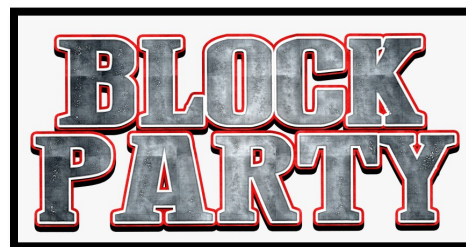
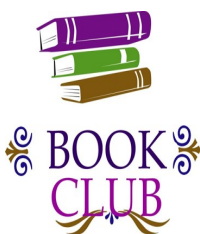
