Stewardship Thought

“We know that all things work for good for those who love God, who are called according to his purpose.”
- ROMANS 8:28

Do you really trust God? Do you really believe that God will provide all that you need? Faith is a challenge for everyone at times. Putting our trust in God, in everything we do, in good times and in bad, means that God's plan for our lives may be quite different than what we planned. When one door closes, another one opens. Trust in God, His plan is always better.

AN UNDERSTANDING HEART

One of the most misunderstood aspects of the Christian life is the way many Christians approach prayer. In an effort, at a time when most people could not read or write, or books were not readily available, different devotions came about to engage people in prayer. The great mistake is that many never moved beyond this, even to this day. If we look at our various novenas, they have one thing in common, petitioning God to do something for us. While our Lord without doubt wants to assist us in our walk through this life, a prayer life left at this level is quite frankly, stunted. It does not accomplish its true goal. In this Sunday's reading from the First Book of Kings we read and hear about the prayer of King Solomon. He could have asked for many things, greater power, more riches, a longer life, conquest of his enemies. Yet Solomon asks for none of these. He asks only for "an understanding heart." This request too, is not for himself but so that he may govern his people rightly and justly. As we read and hear in this passage, the Lord God is pleased with this prayer due the reason that he is not asking for himself but for the good of others. He could easily have ruled his people autocratically and dictatorially as monarchs were absolute at this period in human history. Instead, he understood from his faith that God did not want such a ruler but one who would rule in truth, charity, and justice. The first reading challenges us to ask ourselves how we approach prayer and to ask what our prayer life looks like. Is it little more than petition for our own wants and needs or does our prayer life open itself to the world around us, to people in need, seeking the wisdom we need to know right from wrong and the strength to live this in our daily life. While it is true that Solomon would have his own failures and shortcomings as time went on, it was because his prayer had become distorted and he fell into the trap of self-interest and a loss of wisdom. It was not because God was not listening to him; he, rather, was no longer listening to God. I mentioned above that a prayer life centered primarily on petition and rote words does not accomplish the true goal of prayer. The goal is to become like God who is Love. We are to "become love" as St. Therese of Lisieux so eloquently wrote. This love is not confined to those whom we like or agree with. It extends itself to every person without distinction for this is the way we will be judged. It is, as our Lord Himself said, easy to love those who love us; but what about those who do not, or who cause us or others harm? The goal of prayer does not change. It remains the same, to become Love. This is not an easy call from our Lord but it is the only sure way to the Kingdom. The Gospel this Sunday speaks to us of the Kingdom of God being the "pearl of great price." To find the Kingdom of God is to find God Himself. To find God is to find eternal life. Only those who seek an understanding heart with its wisdom and truth, can come to this place. Equally so, the Kingdom of God is meant to grow like a great catch of fish. We are the fishers of men and women but the best fishers are those who witness to God's love in the world. Mahatma Ghandi once wrote, "Oh, I don't reject your Christ. I love your Christ. It is just that so many of you Christians are so unlike your Christ." He went on to write that the Gospel has the power to transform the entire world but that "Christians treat it like no more than a piece of literature." It is easy to see why. "Love your enemies, bless your persecutors, turn to other cheek" are so radical that without that deep commune with God who is Love, and the prayer life that seeks that understanding and wisdom to become Love, we can easily dismiss this and many other teachings of the Lord as we can be very good at self-justification. If we are wise men and women, we will seek an understanding heart, transform the world around us and make it a better, holier, and more faith-filled place every day.

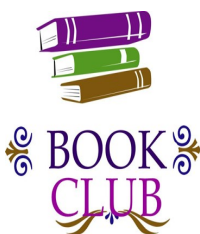

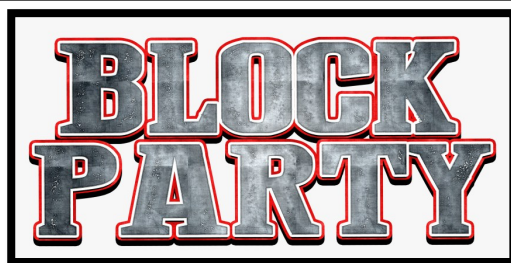

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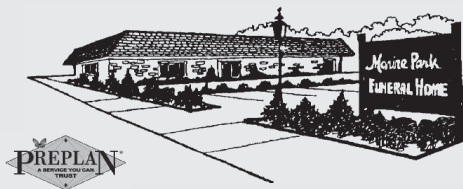
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
