## ***THE SHEPHERD'S VOICE***

Judaism of Jesus' time recognized three major feasts, one of which was Pentecost or Tabernacles. It was a harvest celebration, which came to commemorate the giving of the Law on Mt. Sinai. Pentecost is also one of our "Big Three" Feasts, along with Christmas and Easter.

Why is Pentecost so important? If you look carefully at today's scripture readings, you can see that in the outpouring of the Holy Spirit many themes of the Old Testament are being fulfilled. First of all, this is a "new creation"; Jesus breathes the Holy Spirit on his apostles for peace, forgiveness, and reconciliation, just as Yahweh breathed the breath of life into Adam.

It is a reversal of Babel; men were divided by different languages because of their pride, but the Spirit creates unity: everyone hears Peter speaking his own language.

A new law, a new covenant is given. No longer is the law inscribed on cold, hard stone; this law, given in the Spirit, is written on man's heart, his own spirit. The Spirit of God is blowing over dead, dry bones and bringing them to life.

And the Spirit is offered to everyone in the community from youngest to oldest and in all states of life, just as Joel predicted.

That Spirit is ours for the asking, to be the fire and the animation of this community. Let us pray with the church: "Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of the faithful, and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your spirit and they shall be created and you shall renew the face of the earth".

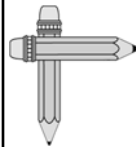
### OUR LADY OF FATIMA 100<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY

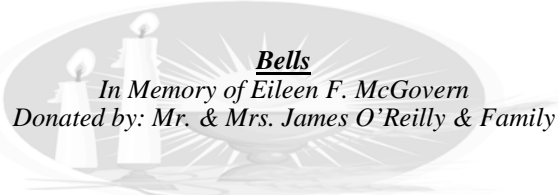
