#### THE SHEPHERD'S VOICE

Dear Parishioners,

Today's liturgy offers us the famous story of Adam and Eve, which many people want to dismiss as a "myth". Myths usually deal with truths that are so basic, so fundamental that they reach back to our human origins.

That is precisely what is involved here; the truth of this story is both psychologically and theologically true to life. It is, however, a truth we are not anxious to hear, because it deals with sin and its consequences.


What their sin, the "original sin" was, we don't know for sure. We do know they were warned by God against doing it, but they found the possibility attractive and believed that asserting their will over God's would make them "like God". We could categorize the sin as pride, willfulness, disobedience, or selfishness, and really all those elements are present in our sins.

What is also obvious is that their selfish choice had consequences on them - even the serpent, on those to be associated with them, and all of us who have come after them, even to this very day. So too our sinful choices impact not only on us but on our families, friends, acquaintances, descendants, and even on the environment that surrounds us.

And as we hear Jesus in today's gospel proclaim the existence of a new family, one based on faith in him, we have to consider the effect our sins have on our own church. In an age when so many would like to deny the reality of sin (and I don't know how anyone who listens to the news broadcasts can do that!) or imagine it hurts no one but themselves, our readings will make us look at sin and evil seriously.


